Research Technologist, Contract Research

Primary Responsibilities

- Perform Laboratory Work
 - Histology
 - Receive and manage specimens and reagents relating to assigned projects
 - Immunohistochemistry
 - Work independently or with other Contract Research team members and with client to design and implement research project testing
 - Assure quality control standards are met and documented
 - Keep supervisor informed of quality control problems and steps initiated to troubleshoot methods and instrumentation
 - Other duties or tasks may be assigned on an as-needed basis such as:
 - Processing and embedding to paraffin
 - Cut frozen tissue sections
 - Cut paraffin sections (if HTL certified)
 - Prepare H&Es or special stains as needed
 - FISH
 - Immunofluorescence
 - Assist pathologist in slide review, transcribing results into worksheets
 - Enter data into computer
 - Label slides as needed for shipment or filling
- Quality Control
 - Assure quality control standards are met and documented
 - Review controls, note any problems, and take whatever corrective action is needed
 - Ensure that lot number information is kept current. Record lot numbers, dates, and titers (as appropriate) in the Reagent inventory, noting when all antibodies and reagents are received, put into service, expired, or used up
 - Update the research antibody files when new antibodies are added and when new uses or titers are established
 - Troubleshoot methods and instrumentation
 - Perform bench testing for GLP projects according to project specific SOPs
 - Document experiments according to GLP and SOP guidelines
- Act as a trainer and resource to less experienced technologists and to laboratory assistants
- Work with Contract Research team in implementation of exploratory testing for clinical trials
- Participate in GLP Projects in compliance with Testing Protocol and GLP requirements
 - Remain current on GLP regulations. Attend all required training.
- Oversee the laboratory equipment maintenance

- Safety, Security, and Waste Handling
 - Follow all company laboratory hazardous waste practices and safety protocols.
- Administrative Duties
 - Write, review, and revise technical procedures and reports
 - Audit data as assigned
 - Help establish and laboratory policies
 - Attend and participate in laboratory meetings.
 - Keep appropriate documentation as described above (control, troubleshooting, lot #, records).
- Other duties or tasks may be assigned on an as-needed basis.
